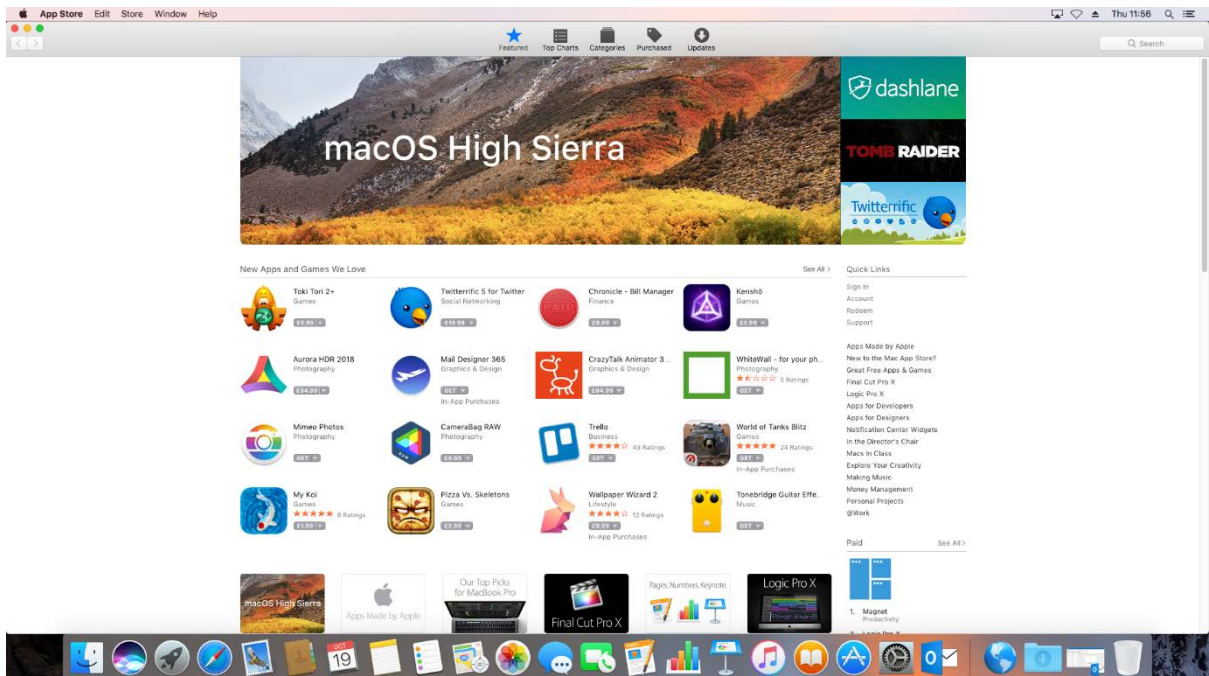


Connecting to remote desktop via macOS

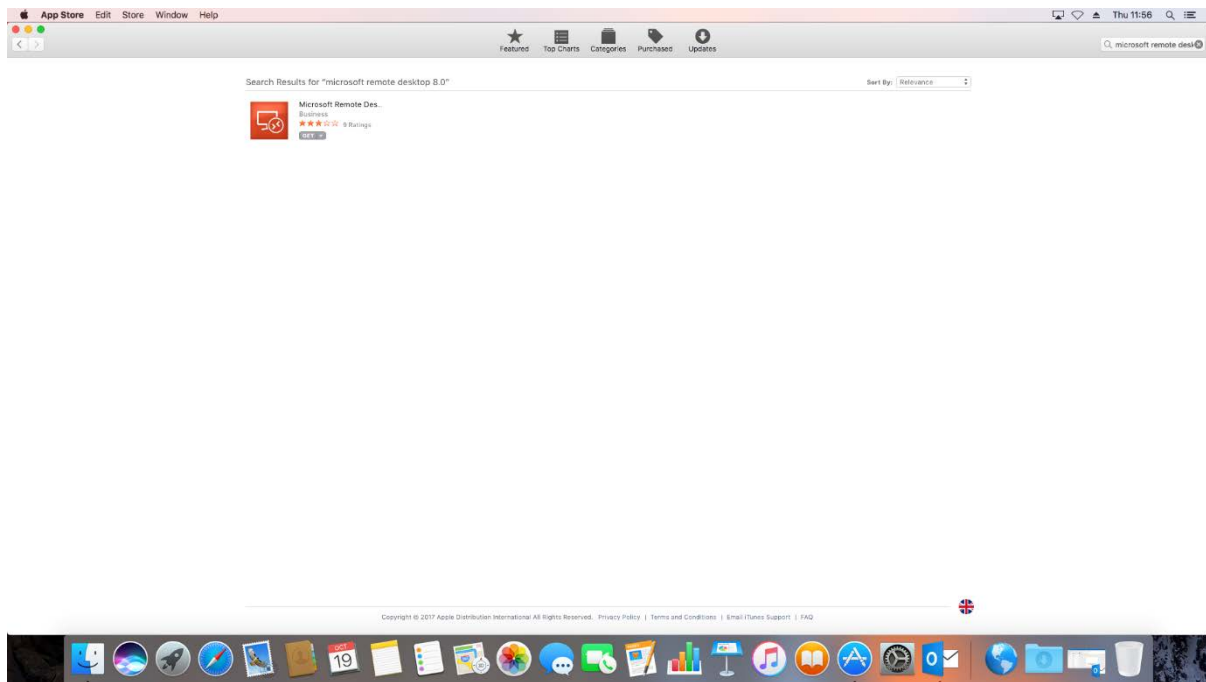
On your macOS Device open your App Store. (In this case it's in the dock)



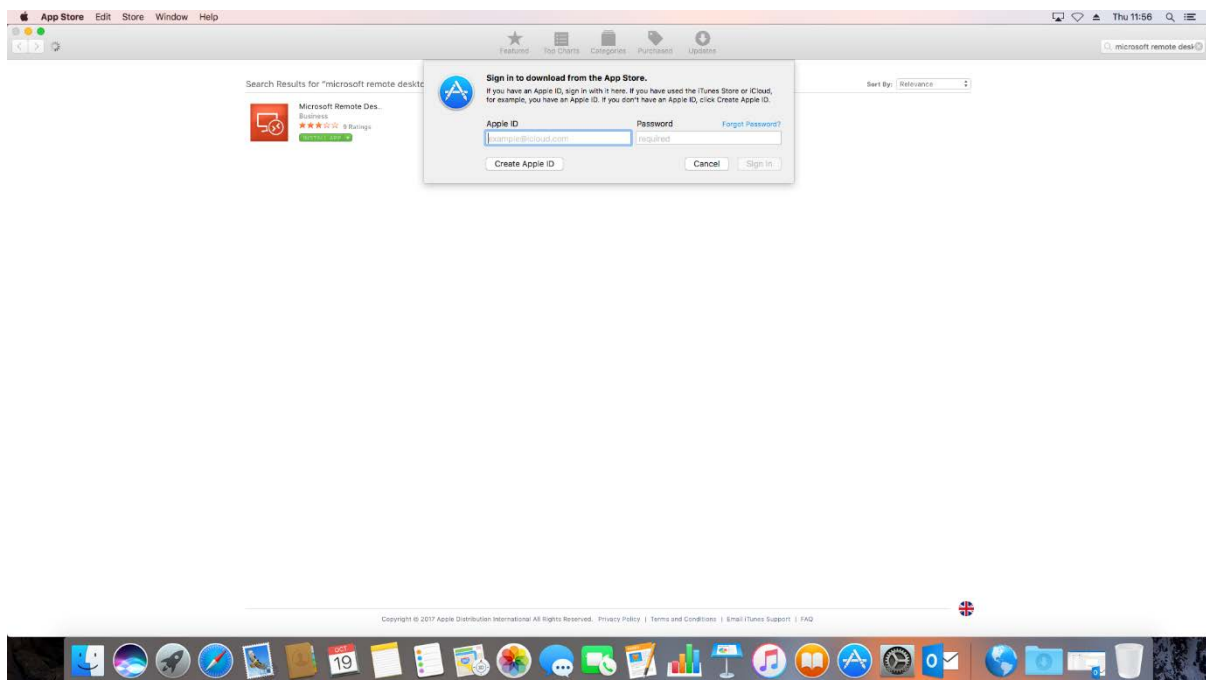
Once you have the App Store open, type in the search box 'Microsoft Remote Desktop'.



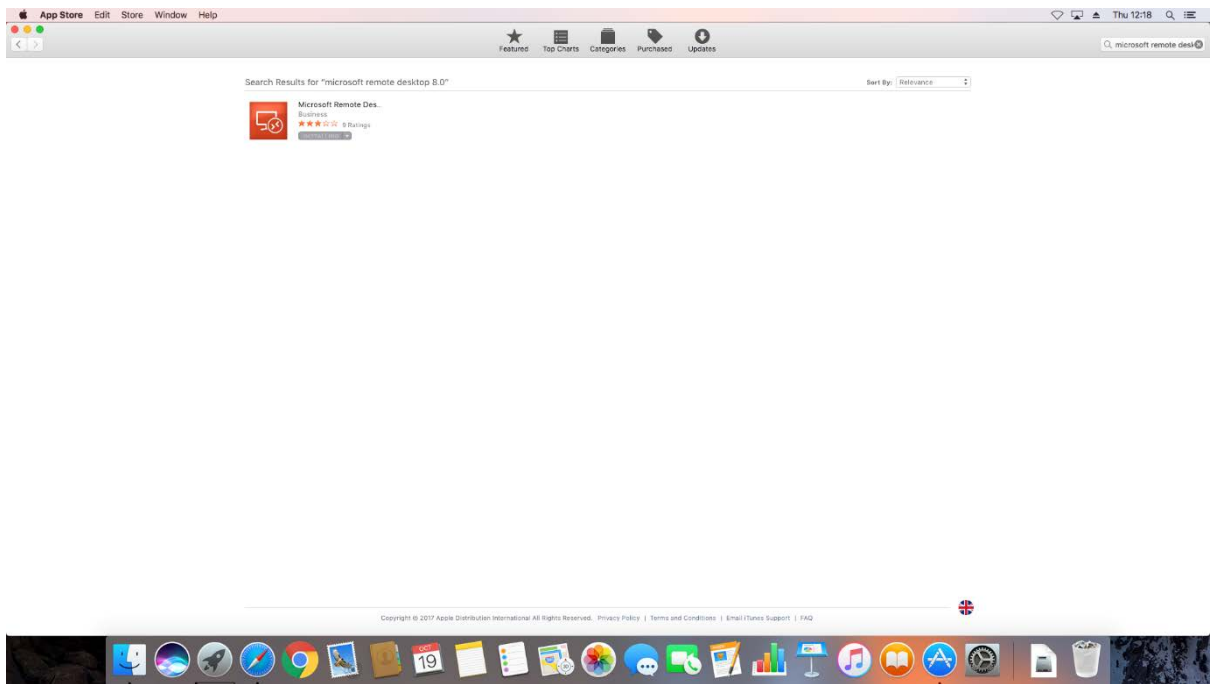
Once you have pressed 'enter' you will see the following application to install.



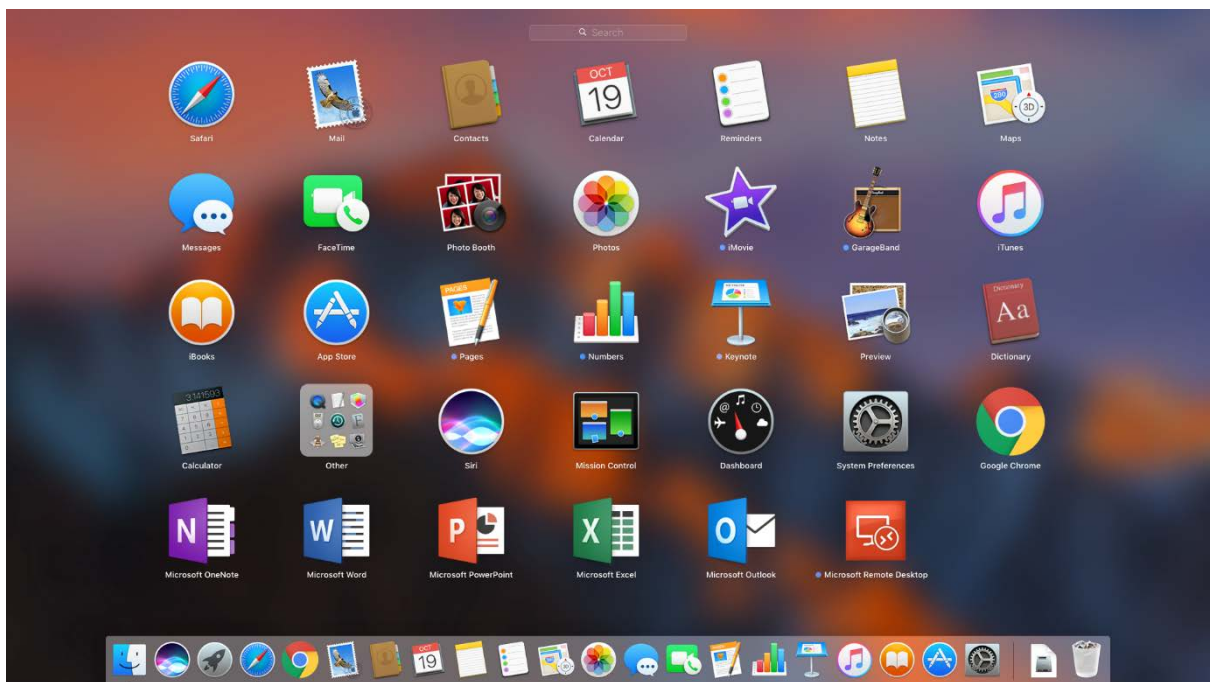
Click on the 'get' button. Where you will be asked to confirm your Apple ID password.



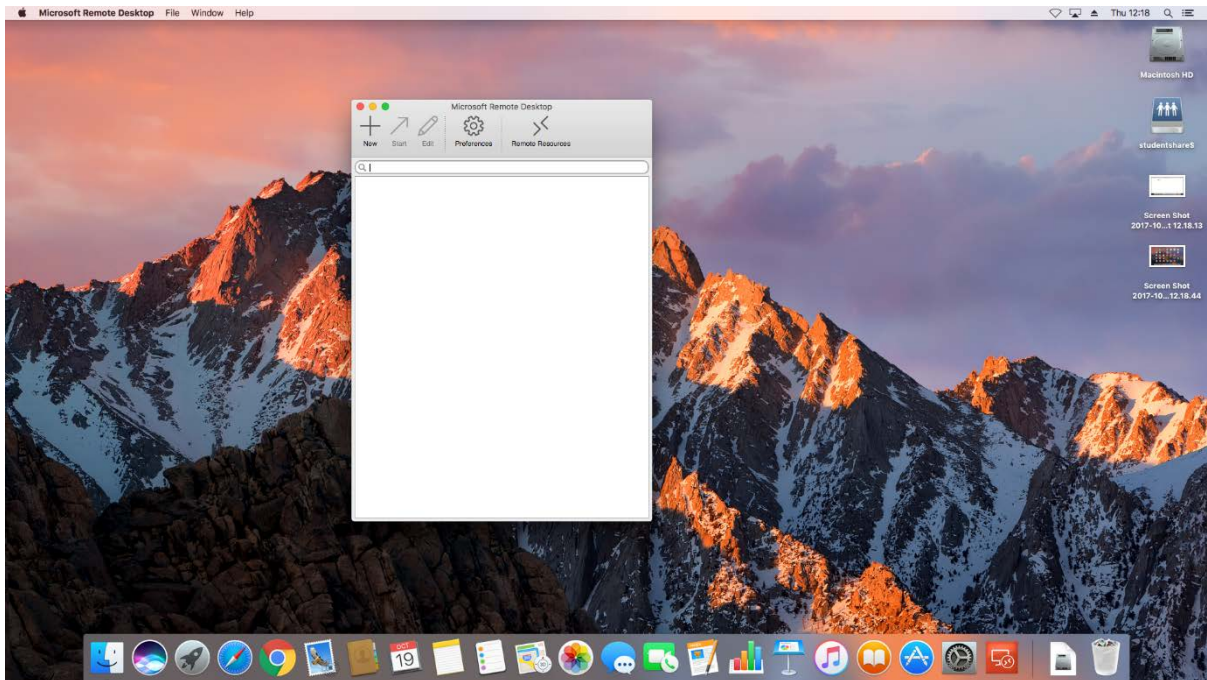
Once you have entered your password, you will see that the app's 'get' badge changes to 'installing'.



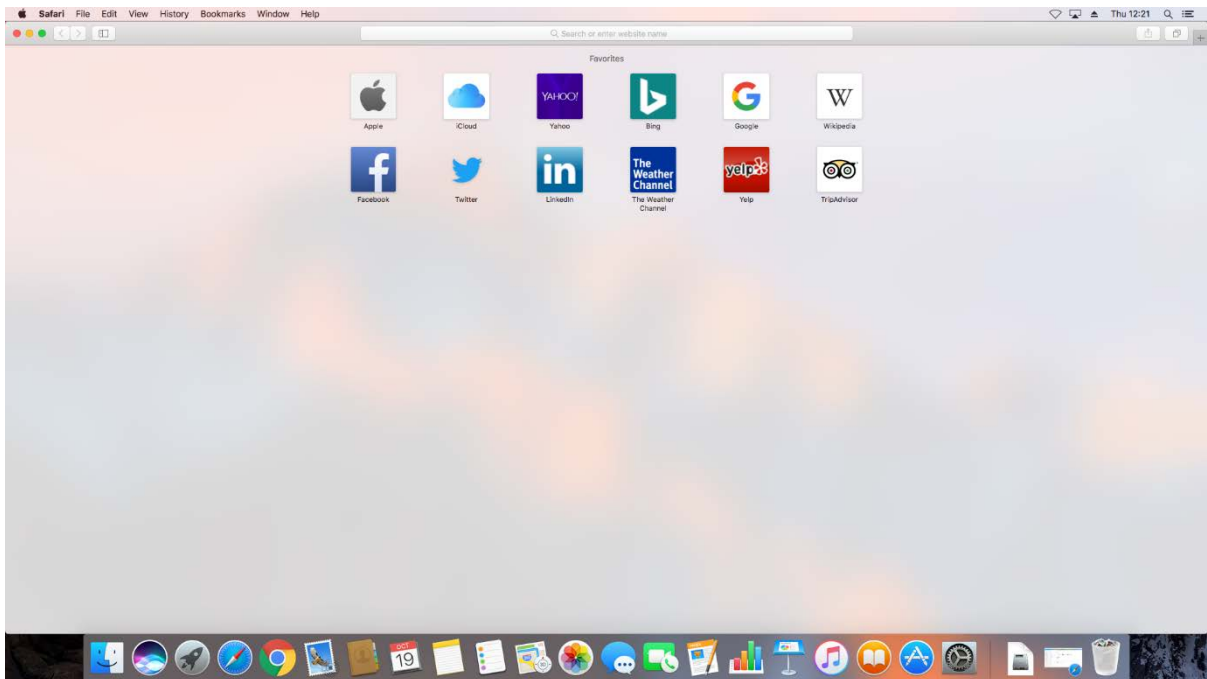
Once the app has been installed you will be able to see the app in your 'Launchpad'.



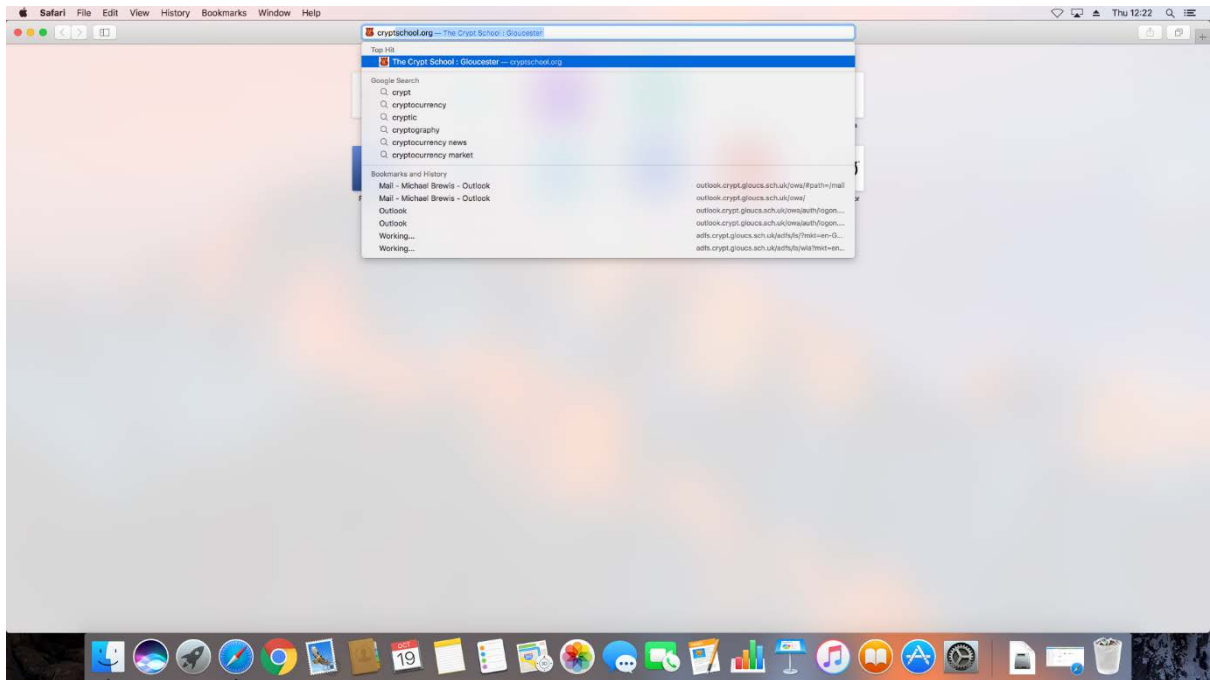
Open the app by clicking on the icon from Launchpad to ensure that the application has installed correctly.



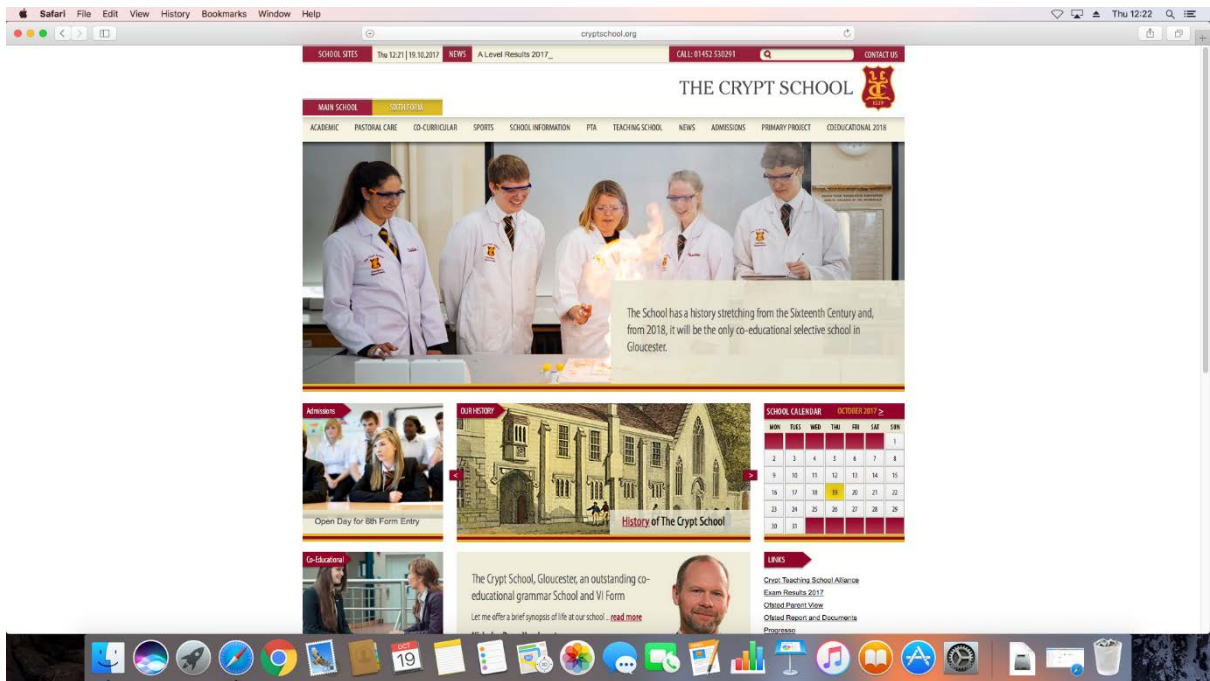
Next open a web browser of your choice (In this case we are using Apple's default Safari)



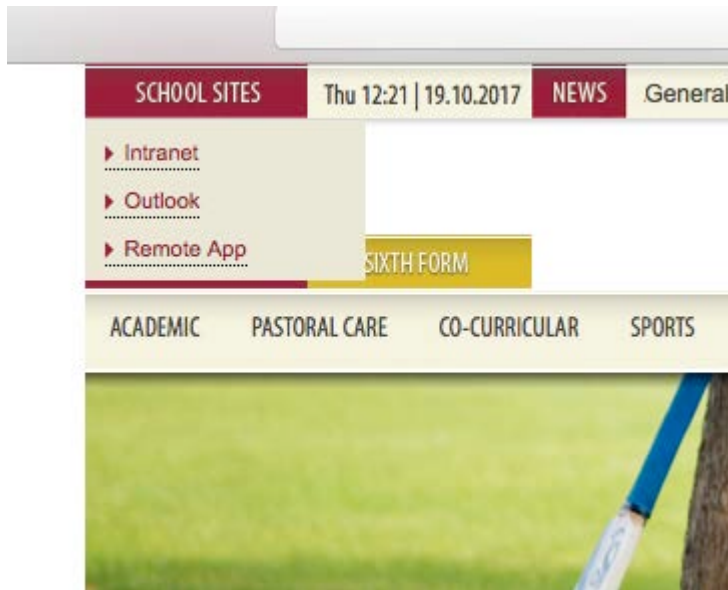
In the top address bar type in 'cryptschool.org'.



Once you are on our website...



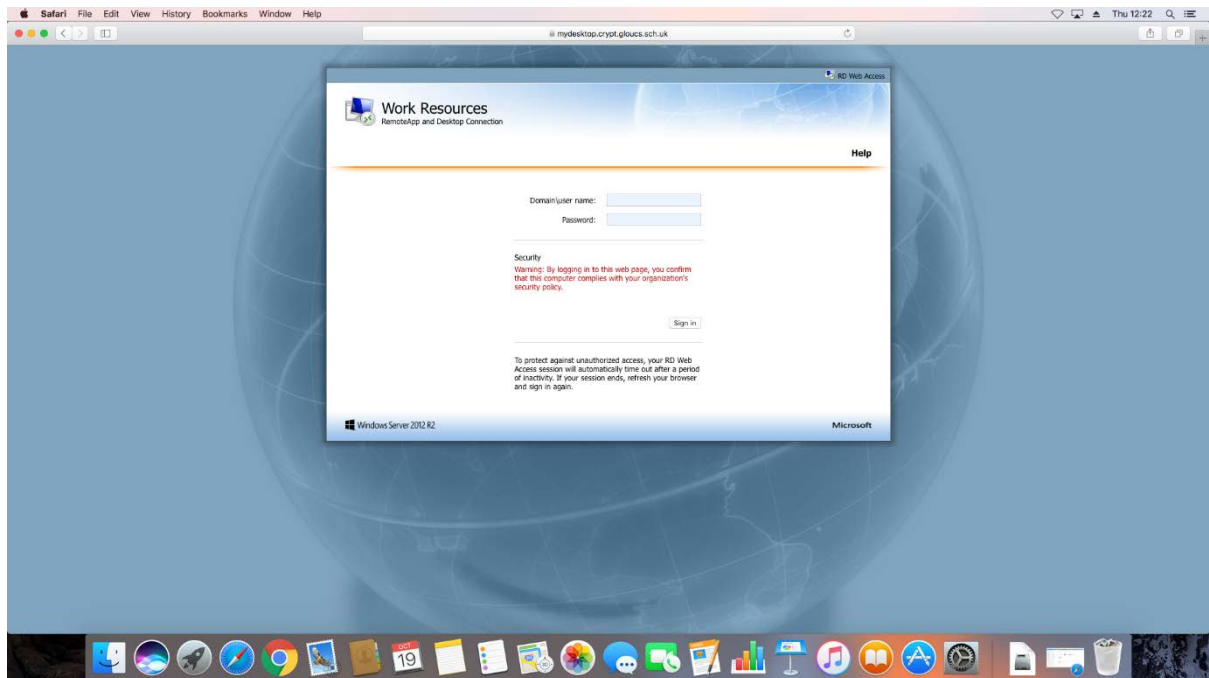
Click 'school sites' and then from the dropdown click 'Remote App'.



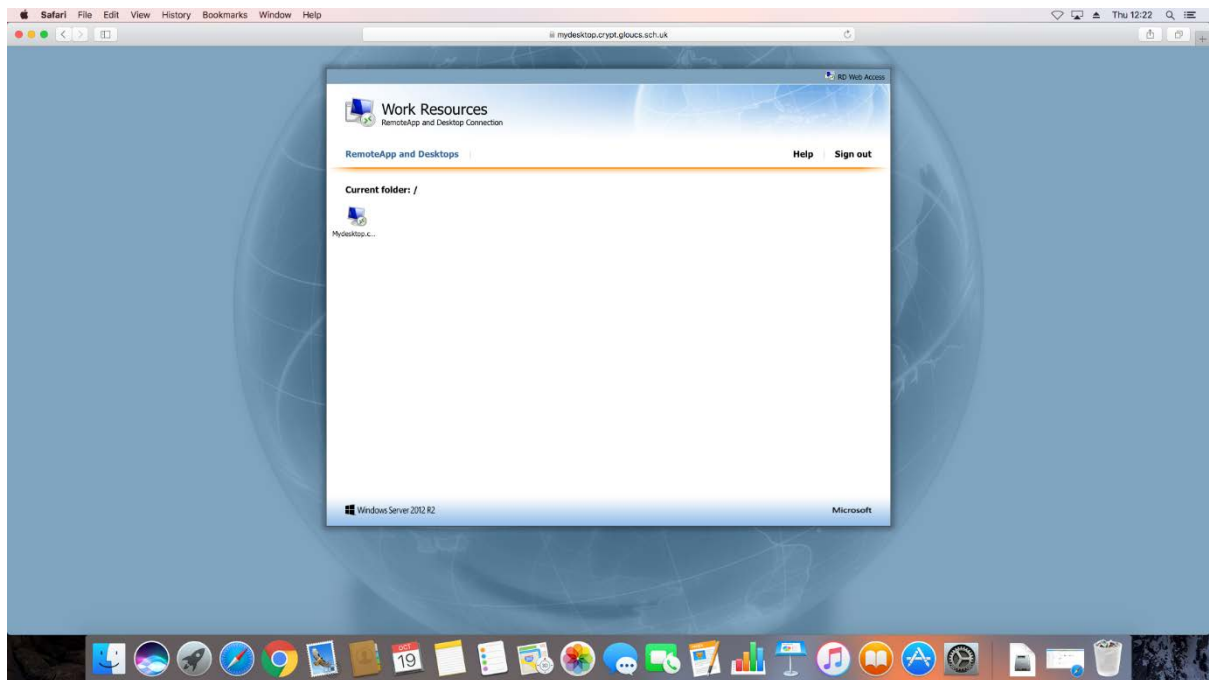
Next, you will be taken to the login page to access our remote desktop. Enter your username but include our domain (which is CRYPT).

For example, 'John Appleseed' will become 'CRYPT\john.appleseed'

The password is the same as the one you use for the school computer.



Next, you will be taken to the following page. Click the computer icon titled 'mydesktop'.



Now it will launch Microsoft Remote Desktop and will display the Crypt School's desktop environment.
