

Promoting British Values

Crypt School believes fervently that a full and rounded education is more than just acquiring knowledge to pass examinations. An essential aspect to our students developing their social capital is the acquisition of a system of beliefs and values that allows them to play their part fully in a democratic society. At the heart of this system are those values we believe to be core to modern British society. These are:

- A respect for the views of others
- An ability to distinguish between right and wrong and the self-confidence to take action when required
- A self-esteem based on consideration and tolerance rather than arrogance
- A willingness to show resilience and perseverance
- A respect for the rule of law and a willingness to engage in the democratic process

Crypt seeks to nurture these core values through both its taught lessons and its extra-curricular activities. Students are expected to show respect for the views and opinions of others and to work towards shared goals. As students progress through the school they are encouraged to take increasing responsibility for their own actions and become “masters of their own destinies”.

Crypt rejects all forms of extremism, bigotry and intolerance and any other such activities it believes to be adverse to the welfare of its students and will take full steps to prevent these entering the school community.
